

Statement about alcohol in cosmetics

(Calw, June 2019) BÖRLIND GmbH uses alcohol in some of its products. Alcohol is a common ingredient in natural cosmetics as it has preserving properties. Alcohol also acts as a solvent for extracts and active ingredients. It has a refreshing, toning and disinfecting effect on the skin.

The alcohol BÖRLIND GmbH uses is obtained from starchy or sugary plants through fermentation. It is pure potable alcohol (ethyl alcohol) and therefore complies with food standards.

This potable alcohol (ingredient or INCI name alcohol) is fermented at BÖRLIND GmbH production premises in the Black Forest, under the supervision of the authorities. Fermentation helps to change the natural smell and taste of alcohol and makes it unpalatable for oral consumption.

Fermentation takes place using natural ingredients, such as perfume oils. They can be recognized by the ingredient name "aroma (fragrance)". Other natural ingredients, such as "glyceryl caprylate" or "sucrose cocoate", are used in this process.

The concentration of alcohol in ANNEMARIE BÖRLIND – Natural Beauty products is so low that it is harmless when applied to the skin as instructed. All ANNEMARIE BÖRLIND products are tested by independent institutes and have been scientifically proven to be effective and safe.
