

Statement about microplastics

(Calw, Germany, February 2015) "Microplastics" is the term given to plastic particles between five micrometers and a maximum of five millimeters in size. In the cosmetics industry, microplastics are often used as exfoliating agents, fillers or binders.

Owing to their small size, some microplastics cannot be filtered out by wastewater treatment plants and so end up in the environment. Since they are not biodegradable, they therefore remain in (drinking) water and accumulate in the food chain. From here, they may also enter the human body if absorbed via drinks or foodstuffs.
